LA BOLDUC

Mary Rose-Anne Bolduc, born to an Irish father and a Metis mother, was a musician and singer of French Canadian music. She was also known as Madame Bolduc or La Bolduc. In the 1930s, she became popular and was called the Queen of Canadian Folk Singers. Many consider her to be Quebec's first singer-songwriter. Her music combined traditional folk styles from Ireland and Quebec, often featuring lively and funny songs. Bolduc lived for a time in New England and regularly toured there to perform for Franco-Americans.
